Chas Morse received a bachelor's degree in Christian Education from Christian Heritage College in 1980, a master's in management from Bellevue University in 1996, a master's in military studies from Maxwell Air Force Base in 2000, a master's in Christian education from the Institute for Creation Research School of Biblical Apologetics in 2011, and a doctorate in pastoral ministry from the Master's Seminary in 2023. While in the Air Force for 26 years, Dr. Morse served as staff sergeant for four years and was later commissioned as a second lieutenant. After retiring from the Air Force as a lieutenant colonel, he joined the Institute for Creation Research in 2009 and now serves as Director of Donor Relations.
